PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear People of God,

As we continue our journey into the Gospel of Mark, we will very quickly see certain themes. In today's gospel reading, we have a very interesting line: the time of fulfillment is at hand; repent and believe in the Gospel. This line from Mark 1:15 sets out Jesus' basic message to the people listening to His preaching. He wants us to know several things: the time of the Messiah's coming is fulfilled, we should repent of our sins, and we need to put our faith in the Gospel. First, we have to remember that the ancient Jews had waited a long time for the coming of the Messiah. The prophets foretold the coming of the Messiah, but they did not say exactly when it would happen. Thus, people were waiting for it to happen. Jesus is saying that that time has come to an end because He has come. Second, we need to repent of our sins. We commonly associate repentance with the feeling of contrition, but the Greek sense of the word means to turn oneself around. In other words, we should walk away from sin, turn around, and walk toward the Lord. Third, Jesus wants us to believe in the Good News of His coming and His payment for our sins. We can have freedom, only by His Blood.

On another note, it is interesting to compare and contrast Mark 1:15 with John 3:16. While John 3:16 is the most memorized verse in the Bible, we can also see how Mark 1:15 also encapsulates the general Gospel message. They both communicate the saving message, but with different words which is a good reminder for us to use our words in the service of the Catholic Faith. We should always be ready to give an explanation of our faith to those who would ask. This should include knowing John 3:16 and Mark 1:15 in addition to knowing other key areas of Scripture.
