#### **PASTOR'S CORNER**

Happy Last Ordinary Time Sunday before Lent!

We all know that God wants what is best for us, but we may not know what that would look like in a detailed fashion. This Gospel reading from Mark shows us the compassion and charity of Christ who is Our Lord. Notice how the leper comes to Him begging for healing on his knees which is a sign of worship. See how he approaches in humility, yet with boldness. The perception that lepers were entirely unclean prevented them from interacting with non-lepers which means that this interaction is quite rare. Lastly, we see how direct this man is with Jesus. There is no mystery as to why he has come.

His request is quick to come as is the healing Jesus works for him. The man is made clean and Jesus does not become unclean from touching him. Though he asks the man not to publicize the event, that is exactly what he does. He runs around telling people about Jesus and the healing that he experienced. We have probably all experienced some form of healing from God. It could have been healing from addiction, illness, unwanted behaviors, something spiritual, emotional pain, or an unwholesome past. Whatever that healing was, we owe God our thanks and worship.

#### **ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY**

Please remember that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of penance, fasting, and abstinence. We do not eat meat on these days and we fast in general from food. You may take one meal and have two lighter in takes of food. Additionally, we recall that our law asks us to refrain from eating meat on Fridays of Lent. This is a laudable practice that can be done throughout the year. In fact, every Friday is supposed to be a day of penance throughout the year per canon 1250. That means we should find something extra to do, like not eating meat, saying additional prayers, or spending more time with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.
