THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. EUGENE

St. Eugene's parish was established on July 1, 1950 by the Most Reverend Archbishop John J. Mitty, Archbishop of San Francisco. It was named after Eugene I, a Roman priest who served as Pope from 654 to his death in 657. The parish was organized and founded by Rev. Erwin J. Becker. The dedication of the new church was held on November 25, 1951. At that time there were few homes or businesses within the parish area. The church was near the eastern outskirts of Santa Rosa. The parish school was opened in 1953. St. Eugene's was designated a Cathedral on February 20, 1962 when the Diocese of Santa Rosa was split off from the Archdiocese of San Francisco.
