*Actual Paid Operations Expenses* are shown for comparison to income. *Plate* is weekly collection income. *Other* includes baptisms, funerals, weddings, fundraising, holy day donations, misc. donations, & facility rental income. *Second Collection* income is paid to other organizations and not used for parish operations. *Year to Date* is the cumulative total for the fiscal year - July 1 through June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Your suggestions will then be reviewed, archived and presented to the Pastoral Council at its quarterly meetings. You will then receive a response to your idea from the Pastoral Council.
