**~CATHEDRAL WALK UPDATE~**

We are on schedule to rebuild the walkway in front of the church and install the engraved bricks this summer. This will require removing existing concrete and replacing it before the bricks can be laid. It may take two weeks or more to be completed. During that time we will place signs, barriers and warning tape around the construction zone. Please adhere to these barriers and warnings for your own safety and to prevent any damage to the construction area. Watch for more information in the bulletin about when the walkway is unavailable for use. During that time we ask that you enter the church from the east entrance and avoid the front entrance.
