All Religious Education Programs

When does registration take place?

Registration for all Religious Education Programs takes place on the last three Sundays of August from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. in the Parish Life Center.

Generations of Faith

How many sessions are there for the Generations of Faith program?

There are five sessions, every other month, beginning in September and ending in May.

What are the dates and times for these sessions?

Generations of Faith is offered on two days, Sunday and Monday. The Sunday session is from 10:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. and the Monday session is from 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. All sessions take place in the Msgr. Becker Center.

Do I need to attend both sessions?

No, it is not necessary to attend both sessions. You may choose the session that best accommodates your situation.

If for some reason I cannot attend on the day for which I have registered one month, may I attend the other day?

Yes, you may attend the alternate day.

What happens if I miss a session?

If you miss a session, you may ask for any handouts that were given at the session, but there is no need to make up a session.

What is the meal that is served?

A light breakfast is served with the Sunday session and a light dinner is served with the Monday session.

What do I do if I have special dietary needs?

Please indicate those needs on the registration form.

Is there homework involved in this program?

No, there is no homework involved, but there are take-home materials available at each session pertaining to the subject for that session.
