**2010 – 2011:** there are five sessions during the 2010–2011 catechetical year (Sep – May) and each session is offered two times - on a Sunday morning and a Monday evening. Each gathering consists of sharing a simple meal, offering prayer and song together, experiencing an overview of the session’s theme and age appropriate break-out groups for focusing on the theme of the session. After the break-out session, the entire group comes back together to share what all have learned, join in a concluding prayer and/or song and be provided with take home materials to continue learning at home.
