### *Spiritual Ministries:*

#### **Friday Morning Scripture**

A weekly Bible study group for adult men and women. Meets on Friday mornings 9:30-11:30 a.m.

#### **Adoration Committee**

Volunteers who schedule committed adorers for the Adoration Chapel and who clean the chapel.

Volunteers who help sell new books & gift items at the on site store to raise money for the parish.

#### **Cathedral Thrift Shop**

Volunteers who process & sell donations of used items at the on site store to raise money for the parish.

Volunteers at the SVDP-St. Eugene's office who provide a wide variety of services to the needy.

#### **Coffee Social Hospitality Committee**

Volunteers who prepare & serve coffee & donuts after Sunday morning masses.

Programs & lunch for the retired and semi-retired to foster religious, social and fraternal relationships. Meets monthly, 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursdays, 12:30-3:00 p.m.

#### **Welcome Committee**

A group who invites newly registered parishioners to their homes for dinner & fellowship.

### *Religious Education and Sacramental Preparation Ministries*

#### **Confirmation Adult Team**

Volunteers who help with meeting facilitation, snack and meal preparation, and carpooling to and from service events for the Youth Ministry Confirmation Program

#### **Generations of Faith Team**

Volunteers who can give of their time and talent in various fields such as set up, meal preparation, and facilitators for the Generations of Faith program.

#### **Junior High Youth Ministry Adult Team**

Volunteers who help with meeting facilitation, snack and meal preparation, and carpooling to and from service events for the Junior High Youth Ministry Program

#### **RCIA Team**

Volunteers who are committed to sharing their Catholic faith with adult inquirers.

Volunteers who serve Communion at masses and who take Communion to sick parishioners.

Volunteers of all ages who provide music weekly at the Sunday 9:00 a.m. mass. *No try-outs required.*

**Hand Bell Choir**

Volunteers who play music using hand bells at Christmas, Easter and special celebrations.

**Lectors**

Volunteers who proclaim scriptures at masses.

**Ushers**

Volunteers who assist with seating at weekend masses and circulate collection baskets.

**Youth Music Team**

High school students and adults who provide music weekly at the Sunday 5:30 p.m. mass.
