~NOTICE OF DEADLINE~

Deadline for filing abuse or other claims against the Diocese of Santa Rosa in regard to: The Roman Catholic Bishop of Santa Rosa, Case No. 23-10113. On March 13, 2023, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Santa Rosa aka Diocese of Santa Rosa ("Debtor") filed for protection under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Debtor, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 20, 2023, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Debtor. Claims based on acts or omissions of the Debtor that occurred before March 13, 2023, must be filed on or before October 20, 2023, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before March 13, 2023.
