## **PASTOR'S CORNER**

In the Gospel of Mark, the Transfiguration is a pivotal moment after Peter has declared Jesus to be the Christ which happens in Mark 8:27-30. Before that in the Gospel of Mark, Jesus demonstrates that He is mighty in word and deed by healing people, expelling demons, and doing things that God alone would be able to do. Mark wants his readers to believe that Jesus is God in the flesh, sent to heal us of our sins. However, immediately after Peter states that Jesus is the Christ, Jesus predicts His Death. The disciples are understandably uncomfortable with this reality and would rather not hear such things. They naturally become afraid. In response, Jesus shows three of them His future glory and theirs as well. Understandably, they do not understand what they are seeing and become confused. Jesus asks not to talk about this until His Resurrection, because only then will it make any sense.

How many times have you had a moment when things did not make sense, and yet later in retrospect, God was able to show you a new way? This is an experience common to the disciples of the Lord and we always give God the glory.
