In romance languages, Lent is usually termed something like Cuaresma or Quadragesima in reference to a four week countdown to this day. In history, this day was Passion Sunday and started a short season of Passiontide. This also explains the other practice of counting down weeks before the beginning of Lent, such as, sexagesima and septuagesima. These would be six and seven weeks before this day. Also, on this day we begin the practice of covering images in the Church. This is a stark way to remind us to keep our eyes and attention on God
